Students have the opportunity of being awarded up to \$2,000 in scholarship money through the Pioneer Chapter with two additional \$1,000 scholarships being awarded by Premier Source FCU.

The contest is open to high school seniors who will be enrolled in an undergraduate college degree program during the 2020-2021 academic year. Applicants, or their parents/guardians, must be members of Premier Source Federal Credit Union.

To enter, each student is required to compose and submit a typewritten essay of up to 250 words based on the theme below. Applicants will be judged on their essays, grades and extracurricular or community activities.

All eligible entries must be received by Premier Source Federal Credit Union by **Friday, February 28, 2020** to be considered.

Eligibility

- Limited to high school seniors who will be enrolled in an undergraduate college degree program during the 2020-2021 academic year.

- SAT/ACT Scores
- List of extracurricular activities and volunteer work
- An essay – which should be no more than 250 words in length
